Hello Families,

Unfortunately, the recent unprecedented surge in community spread of COVID-19 has had a direct impact on the Fairhaven School and our ability to operate effectively during the pandemic.

As a result, I have made the decision to move our educational services to full remote learning effective Monday, November 16th for a two-week period. At the present time, we plan to return to face-to-face learning again starting Monday, November 30th.

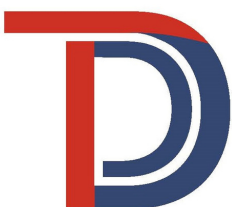
