The New Waiting List Rule Becomes Effective

The Ohio Department of Developmental Disabilities (DODD) recently adopted a new wait list rule. The new rule, effective as of Sept. 1, 2018, includes a standardized statewide waiting list assessment tool. In implementing the new tool, the primary objective is to identify people with a current need for supports and connect them with a resource. In turn, this will allow Trumbull County Board of DD (TCBDD) and DODD to more effectively meet current and future needs of individuals. We are aware the transition and change may cause some confusion. 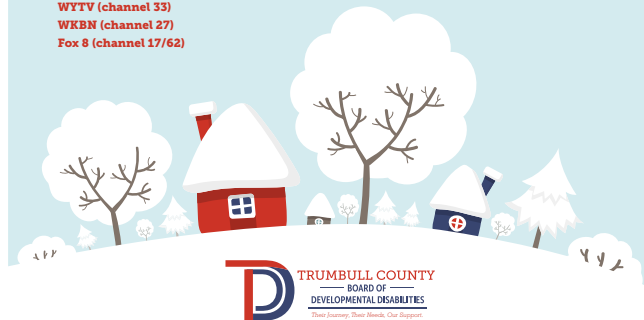
