

# Our History

The Fairhaven Foundation is a 501(c) 3 foundation that was established in 1997. Created by bequest from Pauline Anders. Anders wanted to help children and adults with developmental disabilities that were attending the Fairhaven School and Workshops.

Today, the Foundation seeks to assist the approximately 1,100 individuals eligible for services through the Trumbull County Board of Developmental Disabilities. More than \$30,000 in Foundation funds are distributed annually, with the Fairhaven School also raising tens of thousands of dollars to impact the more than 250 students who attend.

With the Foundation's assistance, individuals receive assistance for:

- *Monthly grocery assistance*
- *Adaptive clothing and equipment*
- *Emergency/Quality of Life grants*
- *Annual movie day*
- *Speech and physical therapy*
- *Fees for sports*
- *Art classes*
- *Defray medical costs*
- *Annual Mahoning Valley Scrappers game*
- *Summer camp options*
- *Attending the annual Art Show event*

## Mission

# Foundation Grants

## 1 EMERGENCY/QUALITY OF LIFE FUND

We all face emergency situations in our lifetime, some more devastating than others. The Emergency/Quality of Life Fund Grant helps individuals when they need it most. Up to \$300 in grant money can be awarded per each request.

## 2 GROCERY FUND

Vouchers for \$40 Save a Lot grocery cards are sent out monthly. Nearly 40 cards are provided each month, providing more-than \$17,000 of annual impact to our community. This fund was created due to cutbacks by Federal and State governmental agencies.

## 3 CAMP FUND

Up to \$200 per request for a summer program or camp to provide personal enrichment.

## 4 MINI GRANT

Up to \$100 per request. Requests have included purchasing seat harnesses, specialty clothing, or other immediate needs.

### The Foundation is always seeking additional funding opportunities!

Executive Director Stephanie Champlin aggressively pursues additional local, state, and national grant dollars to increase programming and impact. Examples at the Fairhaven School include the Fairhaven Bulldog Backpack Program which seeks to reduce childhood hunger, and the Parent Lending Program which will foster language and social-emotional development, while encouraging the power of reading at home. Other grants have benefited our Community Employment, and Grocery Card programs.
